



## **MEMO TO ALL SPORTS OFFICIALS**

Sports Officials working in any sanctioned CYC league or playoff game are Independent Contractors. All sports officials who wish to work CYC sanctioned games or playoffs, therefore, must obtain the following forms, complete them in full and file them with the CYC Sports Officials Association prior to or as soon as possible into the season in which they work.

1. An official Registration Form (obtainable through the CYC Sports Officials Association office)
2. A Federal Form W-9 (also obtainable through the CYC Sports Officials Association office)

These are to be completed in full by the sports official and sent to:

The original forms will be kept in the offices of the CYC Sports Officials Association and copies should be provided by the official to any parish athletic association or District with whom he/she contracts to work.

Every sports official over the age of 18 and desiring to work in leagues or playoffs in which children under the age of 18 are participating, must be in compliance with the Archdiocesan mandate for Protecting God's Children. That is, each official must:

1. Attend a Protecting God's Children workshop.
2. Have had a Missouri criminal background check within the previous two years.
3. Read and sign off on the Archdiocesan Code of Ethical Conduct.

Catholic officials can get information regarding these requirements from their pastor or parish child safety coordinator. Non-Catholic officials can get information regarding these requirements from their District or from the CYC Office.
